



NITROUS OXIDE INFORMED CONSENT

Nitrous oxide is a colorless and virtually odorless gas with a faint, sweet smell. It is an effective analgesic/anxiolytic agent with little effect on the respiratory system. We use nitrous oxide to calm patients and to provide additional analgesia during dental procedures.

Although nitrous oxide has an excellent safety record, there is a small risk of undesired side effects to include:

- Nausea and vomiting.
- Diffusion hypoxia that may lead to headache and disorientation.
- Malignant hyperthermia.

I understand the possible side effects listed above and consent to the use of nitrous oxide during my dental procedure anyway.
